

Topic/Thesis/Project-Product Samples

When choosing a senior project topic, refrain from selecting a topic that you think will be “easy.” Many seniors upon reflection, especially after seeing the topics of other students during the Senior Project presentations, regret having taken the “easy” path. As you are choosing your topic, keep in mind that you are not just writing a report. You must also do field work that relates to the topic. Here are examples of acceptable projects:

Example #1

Topic:	The Art of Cartooning
Thesis Statement:	Cartooning can be a powerful tool to express ideas.
Project/Product: be used and explain your	Take art lessons. Then, design a character for a mascot to be used by a school or neighborhood group. Present design to the organization.

Example #2

Topic:	Public Relations
Thesis Statement: positive link	Public relations are an important method to establish a link with the community.
Project/Product: organize a your	Interview an expert who works in the field. Volunteer to organize a campaign to promote an event in your school or in your community.

Example #3

Topic:	Elder Care
Thesis Statement:	Growing problem of elder abuse in our society needs to be addressed.
Project/Product: caregiver. the problems and	Volunteer at a nursing home. Interview a resident or caregiver. Create a video or photo journal documenting the problems and urging action to provide solutions.

Example #4

Topic:	Peer Pressure
Thesis Statement:	Peer pressure influences young people in both positive and negative ways.
Project/Product: you have play for a real	Write and direct a play highlighting important issues that you have learned through your research. Perform the play for a real audience.
