PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO CHARTER SCHOOL POLICY

The School Reform Commission (SRC) of The School District of Philadelphia (SDP) seeks public comment on a draft amendment to its Charter School Policy. The amendment to the policy anticipates a process by which charter schools may apply to increase student enrollment levels and/or alter existing grade configurations. The SRC is considering the addition of Section VII, entitled, "Procedures for Addressing Requests for Enrollment Increases and Grade Reconfigurations" to the current Charter School Policy.

The SRC anticipates considering a vote to amend its Charter School Policy at one of its fall 2009 meetings and seeks to solicit feedback on the draft policy. We encourage you to submit comments in writing or via email.
