Starting in September 2009, the District wants one parent (and one alternate) *per school* to serve on a District-wide Parents 'R' Equal Partners (PREP) Team. Considering the diversity within our schools, we encourage participation from our most under-represented groups; including limited English proficient parents, males, parents of low-performing students, and grandparents/caregivers. While membership in the Home and School Association or any other organized parent group is **NOT** a requirement, we encourage you to share this information with your Home and School Association President or other parent representative.

PREP representatives will receive quarterly training and information about Title I's rules and regulations. Topics will include (but not be limited to) parents' rights and responsibilities, state and local assessments, academic achievement gaps, the school improvement process, and supplemental educational services. We ask that each PREP representative (and/or alternate) offer turn-around training to the parents in their respective schools.

The Regional Parent Ombudsmen, Regional NCLB Liaison, Regional Parent Advisory Committee (PAC) members, District Staff in the Office of Parent, Family, and Community Engagement, and school-based Parent Ombudsmen will be available to assist with the turn-around training at the schools. Please post this information in a prominent location in your school office. Names of *all* interested parents should be submitted **ASAP**.
