

JOB OPPORTUNITY

CINEMATOGRAPHY AND FILM/VIDEO INSTRUCTOR

Beginning December 21, 2010, a Philadelphia School District Career & Technical Education Cinematography and Video/Film Production teacher will be needed to assist the student members of the College Attainment Committee in creating a video to promote college readiness. This project will take place after school hours.

The Career & Technical Education Cinematography and Video/Film Production teacher will be paid up to seventy-five (75) hours at the extra curricular rate.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

- Considerable knowledge of the Cinematography and Video/Film Production industry.
- Considerable knowledge of computer photographic imaging and editing software, including Final Cut Pro, Avid, Adobe Creative Suites etc.
- Considerable knowledge of the modern methods, theories and practices in the career area.
- Considerable knowledge of the materials and techniques used in the career area.
- Considerable knowledge of the safety procedures related to the industry.
- Considerable knowledge of the proper care and use of tools and equipment used in the industry.
- Possession of a valid Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Vocational/Intern Certificate in the area of Cinematography and Video/Film Production
- Have an excellent attendance and punctuality record during the last three (3) years defined as no more than eighteen (18) occasions of lateness or absences for personal illness in the last three (3) years. A consecutive period of absence constitutes one occasion.
- Have no unsatisfactory documentation on file.
